## Perry Hall Behavioral Expectations and Guidelines

In addition to complying with all federal, state, and local laws, residents are expected to comply with the guidelines below. Failure to comply with these guidelines could result in removal from Perry Hall. SUNY CCC reserves the right to amend the policies and guidelines contained in this document.

**Alcohol** – No resident or guest, regardless of age, may possess, consume, store, or distribute alcoholic beverages within Perry Hall or on SUNY CCC property. This includes empty alcohol containers. In addition, any resident under the influence of alcohol who brings attention to himself or herself by making noise or general disruption or publicly displaying intoxication is in violation of this policy. Any alcohol found on the property will be disposed of immediately.

All residents are prohibited from the illegal use, manufacture, possession, or distribution of all controlled substances on the campus. Any violations of this policy will result in action up to and including removal from Perry Hall, whichever is appropriate. Smoking paraphernalia (vapes, e-cigarettes, pipes, hookahs, rolling papers, etc.) found in rooms will be viewed as a violation of this policy. In addition, violations of this policy may be reported to civil authorities.

**Animals** – With the exception of service animals, no animals or pets are permitted in Perry Hall.

**Cleaning** – Residents are responsible for removing trash and recyclable items regularly. Residents are also responsible for maintaining satisfactory health and life safety standards and cleaning their own rooms, suites, and all areas (i.e. bathrooms, and living rooms), including all furniture, fixtures, appliances and areas not routinely cleaned by maintenance personnel. All furnishings must remain in assigned room or designated location. Any damage or excessive cleaning needed above and beyond what is considered normal may result in additional charges.

**Endangering Behavior** – Any conduct that threatens and/or endangers the health and/or safety of a person(s) or property is prohibited.

**Fire Safety** – Do not tamper with fire/smoke alarms, fire-fighting equipment, elevators, or other security/safety equipment.

**Firearms and Other Weapons** – Firearms and other weapons are not permitted on SUNY CCC property or in Perry Hall at any time. This includes, but is not limited to, hunting rifles, hand guns, paint ball guns, BB guns, stun guns, very realistic looking toy guns or replicas, switchblades, gravity knives, box cutters, bows and arrows, stun guns, self-defense spray devices, ammunition of any kind, and any martial arts weapons (ex. chukka sticks, throwing stars, etc.). Use of any object against another person will be considered a cause for removal from Perry Hall.

**Keys & ID Cards** – Residents are responsible for all keys and access cards issued to them. Residents are prohibited from lending or giving their keys or access cards to other individuals. Lost, stolen or damaged keys or access cards must be reported immediately and will necessitate the replacement of the lock(s), key(s), or access card, the cost of which is charged to the resident.

**Quiet and Courtesy Hours** – Courtesy hours are 24/7. If asked to quiet down please respect the request of the requestor or you may be asked to leave. No playing of musical instruments or loud music in Perry Hall. Quiet hours are between the hours of 11PM to 10AM (daily).

**Sexual Misconduct** – All forms of sexual violence and misconduct, which include, but are not limited to acts of sexual harassment, sexual violence, sexual coercion, sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, rape criminal sexual acts, forcible touching, and sexual abuse are explicitly prohibited.

**Smoking** – SUNY CCC is 100% tobacco-free. Tobacco products of any type are not permitted anywhere inside Perry Hall or any SUNY CCC property.

**Theft** – Theft from, or damage to, SUNY CCC premises or property is prohibited.

**Vandalism** – Vandalism, including defacing or destroying of SUNY CCC property, or the property of others, will not be tolerated.
